## *Franklin County Field days 2018 flower show*

### *Division 1 - Flower Design*

- Please pre-register your entry for Division 1, Division 2 and Division 4 using email or the above telephone number.
- An exhibitor may enter as many classes as desired, but only ONE exhibit per class.
- Each design must be the work of one individual.
- No artificial flowers, fruit or foliage permitted except for Division 1, Class 2 and Division 4, Class 3.
- All designs must contain some fresh plant material (except Division 1, Class 2)
- Fresh plant material may never be treated or embellished in any way.
- Exhibitor may use additional staging, but must use properties provided and only the space allowed. Please see individual Class descriptions for allowed, additional embellishments.
- Flowers on the endangered and invasive species lists are not allowed. Lists are available from the state.
- Extra points will be awarded to those who incorporate the theme into their design.
- The Franklin County Field Days and its representatives are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please do not use valuable or irreplaceable items in your displays
- Premiums for the Flower Show, Design Divisions are as follows: 1st Prize: \$5.00 2nd Prize: \$3. 3rd Prize: \$2.00

### *Class 1 - Italy - Lily*

A Creative line design using the National Flower of Italy, the lily. Any type of lily may be used. Size should not exceed 24" (length) x 15" (depth). No height restrictions. Staged with other entries on a flat surface.

### *Class 2 - South Africa - Protea*

A hanging design using the National Flower of South Africa, the protea. This design uses *artificial and/or dried flowers* and may utilize other components such as fabric, wood or metal. No size restrictions. Not to exceed 20" (width) x 20" (length) x 28" (height). The design should be one sided; please include a hanger on the back of your design to hang on the wall. Please, no fresh flowers as we are unable to water designs hanging on the wall.

### *Class 3 - Spain - Red Carnation*

A table wreath design that must contain at least one red carnation, the National Flower of Spain. Size not to exceed 15" x 15". No height restrictions. Staged with other entries on a white draped table.

### *Class 4 - France - Iris*

A square or rectangle floral design using the Iris, the National Flower of France. This design should resemble a French Country flower garden. Not to exceed 24" (width) x 24" (depth) by 20" (height). Staged on White, cloth covered, table or an 18" pedestal, dependent on the number of entries.

### *Class 5 - Netherlands - Tulip*

A mixed floral bouquet design, featuring the National Flower of the Netherlands, the tulip. Note: the TULIP ONLY may be artificial if fresh is not available. All other plant material must be fresh. Not to exceed 15" (width) x 15" (depth) x 24" (height). Staged on a white pedestal in a clear 6" round (4" height) vase (provided).

### *6 - Denmark - Marguerite Daisy*

Capture the beauty of Denmark with a display of beautiful wildflowers, using the National Flower of Denmark, the marguerite daisy (Note: ANY daisy can be used.) Not to exceed 15" (width) x 15" (depth) x 24" (height). Staged with other entries on a white draped table.

### *Class 7 - "United States - Rose*

An arrangement of garden flowers in a 16" (width) x 10" (depth) x 24" (height) space, featuring the National flower of the United States, the rose. An arrangement involves the careful, purposeful placement of flowers in a container. Staged on a 12" white pedestal, or a white draped table, dependent on the number of entries.

## *Division 11 - Mixed Horticulture & Adult Design*

### *Class 1 - Mexico - Dahlia*

A creative floral design incorporating a potted herb, foliage or flowering plant and the National Flower of Mexico, the dahlia. Not to exceed 10" (width) x 10" (depth) x 15" (height). Staged with other entries on a white draped table.

## *III - Horticulture*

- All flowers or plant material used shall be grown by the exhibitor for at least 8 weeks.
- No wire permitted above the flower line.
- No artificial color allowed.
- Only 2 entries per person in each class.
- Each entry in Class 1, Class 2, Class 3 and Class 6 should be 1-3 stems only, with no leaves below the water line.
- Exhibitors must furnish their own clear see-through container. No beer cans, wine or soda bottles.
- Premiums for Division III -Horticulture are as follows:  
1st prize: \$3.00      2nd prize: \$2.00      3rd prize: \$1.00

No pot larger than 8" in diameter.

### *Class 7 – Foliage Potted Plants, hanging.*

No pot larger than 10" in diameter. Please include a sturdy hanger.

### *Class 8 – Foliage Potted Plants, standing.*

No pot larger than 8" in diameter.

## *Division IV – For Children Only*

- Any flower or plant material shall be fresh. No artificial color allowed.
- Only 1 entry per person in each class.
- Exhibitors must furnish their own vases. No beer cans, wine or soda bottles.

### *Class 1- Ireland - Shamrock*

A garden flower design using the National Flower of Ireland, the shamrock. Note: Clover may be substituted for the Shamrock. Not to exceed 15" (width) x 8" (depth) x 15" (height). Staged with other entries on a white table.

B.      Ages 6-10  
C.      Ages 11-15

### *Class 2 – Scotland - Thistle*

Create a beautiful wildflower vase display. The National Flower of Scotland, the thistle, should be incorporated into the design. Creative vases are encouraged. Not to exceed 15" (width) x 8" (depth) x 15" (height). Staged with other entries on a white covered table.

- A.      Ages 3-5  
B.      Ages 6-10  
C.      Ages 11-15

### *Class 3 – Wales – Daffodil*

Create a square or rectangle garden, *using artificial or dried flowers*, featuring the National Flower of Wales, the daffodil. Staged with other entries on a decorated table. Not to exceed 15" x 15". No height restrictions.

- A. Ages 3-5
- B. Ages 6-10
- C. Ages 11-15

Exhibits will be registered on Wednesday afternoon/ evening between 12pm and 6pm. You may drop your exhibits earlier on Wednesday, at your own risk. They may be moved if dropped off earlier than 12pm. Exhibits will be judged starting at 6:15pm Wednesday evening. The decision of the judge(s) will be considered final. All entries MUST stay on display until **5pm** Sunday and be picked up at that time. Ribbons and premium money must be picked up with your entry. All premium monies are forfeited if not picked up by 5:30pm. All unclaimed flower arrangements will be disposed of at 5:30pm.
